

## Welcome to THE SITE

**The Site** is a project developed by Southlanders Learning Zone in partnership with the Learning & Skills Council and with input from West Sussex County Council Adult & Community Education Service.

**The Site** provides Southlanders [*a local residents group*] with access to the every changing world of the computer.

Initially designed to allow Southlanders to benefit from receiving basic computer skills, it has very quickly evolved into a centre which now can provide a wide range of services to the local residents

Southlanders are now able to provide the local community of Adur and beyond with access to this Centre.

### ***How it works!!***

- An organisation decides that its users or members would benefit from **The Site** visiting their location either for a "*once of event*" or on a regular basis.
- The organisation contacts Southlanders to arrange a date/time and location
- **The Site** will then come to the organisation's location, with the services of our "techoguru" [Matt]
- Matt will set up **The Site** and provide support throughout the session
- Matt will then dismantle **The Centre** at the end of the session

**All the organisation has to ensure is that there is a wall socket available**

## THE SITE

Services currently on offer include:

- Use of up to 5 laptop computers [all running Microsoft Vista and with a wide range of software preloaded]
- Free access to the internet for the duration of the session
- Ability for users to:
  - convert VHS videos to DVD's
  - convert LP's to CD's
  - convert cassettes to CD's
- Full media centre cover for conferences or meetings
- Full media support for presentations etc.
- Production of or assistance with a wide range of publicity ranging from digital photography to DVD recording of events
- Assistance with a wide range of ICT projects such as the repair & digitizing of home photographs
